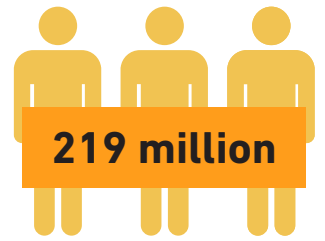


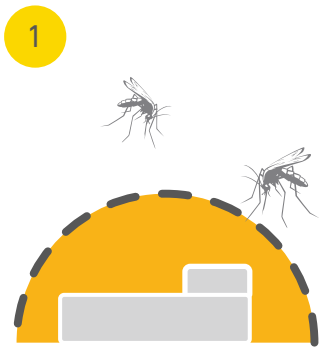
- An estimated **219 million** cases occur each year.

- It remains a **health risk** for more than half of the world's population.



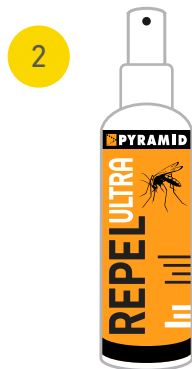
What Causes It?

Prevent Malaria With...



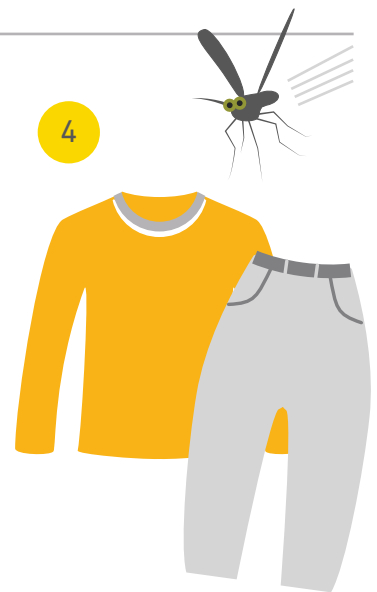
Treated mosquito nets

Prevention Better than Treatment

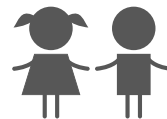


Resistance to antimalarial medicines has been a problem in recent years in...
